ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION

ID VERIFICATION:

All students must present School ID with matching registration names at the event for age verification. It is mandatory to match the names on your ID and Registration.

AGE CATEGORIES:

Students of classes 5 to 12 can participate

• Category 1 (Class: 5 to 8)

• Category 2 (Class: 9 to 12)

ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION:

To participate in the event, follow these guidelines:

- Confirm you're within **CATEGORY 1** or **CATEGORY 2** age range, in a team of two.
- Indicate your preference to attend the event in person during registration.
- Have your School ID ready for age verification at the event.



EVENT STRUCTURE

OPENING STATEMENTS

Each Participant has 3-5 minutes to introduce their stance on the topic and outline their arguments after 3 mins time bell, 5 mins double bell (time over)

REBUTTAL AND CROSS-EXAMINATION:

Participants can interrogate the opposing viewpoints by questions, counter arguments, seeking clarity and exposing weaknesses..

MAIN DEBATE:

Participants, present their arguments logically with facts and statistics often with allocated time slots.

CLOSING STATEMENTS:

Participants can offer concise summaries for their key points to leave a memorable impression



PREPARATION

HERE'S A GUIDE ON HOW TO PREPARE EFFECTIVELY:

UNDERSTAND YOUR TOPIC:

Begin by gaining a deep understanding of what "Youth Empowerment" entails. Research the concept, its importance, and the various aspects it covers, such as education, employment, healthcare, and political participation.

RESEARCH YOUR TOPICS:

- Research each topic thoroughly to understand its nuances, historical context, and the various perspectives surrounding it.
 - Compile data, statistics, and credible sources to support your arguments during debates

REPRESENT YOUR DISTRICT:

Each student will be assigned a district. You are required to represent that district and focus on youth empowerment issues, initiatives, and opportunities in that specific region. Highlight district-specific challenges, success stories, and recommendations for improvement.

ANALYZE CURRENT POLICIES:

- Evaluate existing government policies and programs aimed at youth empowerment.
 Understand their strengths, weaknesses, and areas for improvement.
- Effective communication is crucial for participating in debates. Work on improving your public speaking, articulation, and persuasion skills



RULES OF CONDUCT

RESPECT AND DECORUM: Maintain a high level of respect and decorum during all IYP sessions. Treat fellow participants, organizers, and guests with courtesy.

ATTENDANCE: Be punctual and attend all scheduled sessions, briefings, and events. Notify organizers in advance if you cannot attend.

PARTICIPATION: Actively participate in debates, discussions, and activities. Engage in constructive dialogue, and listen attentively to others viewpoints.

PROFESSIONALISM: Dress appropriately and conduct yourself professionally throughout the event. Uphold the dignity of the parliamentary setting.

NON-DISCRIMINATION: Refrain from any form of discrimination or bias based on race, gender, religion, or nationality. Promote inclusivity and diversity.

POLICY PROPOSALS: Prepare well-structured policy proposals related to the assigned topics. Offer practical solutions and suggestions.

RULES AND REGULATIONS: Set by YUCI will be final and violating which the team will be terminated with effect immediately.

NOTE: Parents are not allowed to attend or interfere during the sessions, events, or activities. This ensures an independent and professional environment for all participants.



CRITERIA

PARTICIPANTS ARRANGEMENTS

- Participants are expected to be on time.
- Participants are respectfully advised to make individual meal arrangements.

RECOGNITION

Trophy and hard copy certificates will be provided.



GRADING AND MARKING THE TEAMS

Each team will be evaluated by:

By the Judge

CRITERIA FOR EVALUATION BY THE JUDGE:

Content (5 points):

Clarity of Argument, Logical Structure, Use of Evidence, Rebuttal Skills, Overall Persuasiveness

Delivery (3 points):

Speaking Style, Voice Clarity, Confidence, Time Management

Engagement (1 points):

Audience Interaction, Response to Questions

Individual Participation (1 point):

Active Involvement, Initiative Taken, Individual Contribution, Personal Effort



COMMENTS AND FEEDBACK FROM BOTH JUDGES AND FELLOW MEMBERS:

- Strengths
- Areas for Improvement

NOTE: Judges will provide specific feedback and scores for each criterion, and the total score should reflect the team's overall performance. The judging panel may consist of multiple judges, and the final score can be an average of their individual scores.

THE FINAL SCORE WILL BE BASED ON THE MARKING BY JUDGE, THE DECISION IS FINALIZED BY JUDGE.
